The one large item remaining - heat. After much study & investigation, we have defined a reasonable way to get thru this year. A group is going up soon to try to do this, hooking up enough <sup>additional</sup> radiators to reach the reasonable capacity of the boiler. That plus the storm windows should carry us through this year. This will be done early in December, & then I will let the real snow start.

Linens are being done by a laundry and delivered. They cost 30¢ per bed until experience shows different. There is generally 1 blanket/bed, and one <sup>or</sup> <sup>additional</sup> more might be of value, depending on you. Don't say you weren't warned.

## Lodge use

The lodge ~~is~~ <sup>is now</sup> open for use - and all members are urged to use it.

Before the season, one couple <sup>(if several are going)</sup> each weekend will be designated by Polly Cowan as responsible for opening and closing the lodge, or making sure the last one out ~~checks the door~~ closes up. Generally the caretaker will open & close the building, but if a trip is set on short notice, or if he is not available when I try to reach him, a checklist will be supplied to each group going up.


During the season, a host and hostess will be assigned for each weekend.
