Lodge committee report - House rules.

The following ~~is~~ an attempt to clarify some of the decisions made regarding the kitchen, meals, food at the lodge, time of meals, serving procedure, laundry, beds, etc, etc. Please note these decisions are based on getting thru the 1st year with our current resources.

Meal reservations are made with ~~room~~ ^{room} reservations, and ~~must~~ ^{will} be charged for ~~whether~~ ^{whether} you are at the meal or not. Cancellation of meals is the same procedure as ^{cancellation of} room reservations.

The cook is responsible for preparing the meals and cleaning the kitchen & dishes. The club is responsible for getting ~~the~~ food to the lodge (some food will have to be brought up each weekend), serving the food, clearing & cleaning the dining room. Each weekend, one person will be kitchen hostess, and will be assigned ^{by the women's committee,} and briefed before the weekend. This being one of the main jobs, it should not be assigned to the same person more than once a season. Each weekend there also will be several people, ^(kitchen assistants) assigned to dining room & kitchen ~~duties~~ for one meal. This consists of serving food & is not difficult but is essential. From the experience of our first weekend with the cook, having enough people helping at the right time is the only way to have an organized meal. ~~the~~

In general the serving procedure will be -
 Breakfast. Self service, cafeteria style.

Dinner: served ~~by~~ by one person per table, family style.

The pig kitchen is not to be used after hours
~~when the cook is on~~ week-ends the cook is there.

When the kitchen is used on week-ends
 when Mrs. Shepard is not there, those using
 it must leave it as they found it.

Club food may not be used by the club
 at large, except for unmarked food in
 the 1st. motel kitchen.

If you bring any of your own food to the
 lodge, mark it with your name and leave
 it in the 1st motel ^{kitchen} or in the room behind
 the kitchen. We are not responsible for any
 private food ~~at~~ ^{brought} to the lodge.

On week-ends when food is being served
 milk will be available at all times,
 however since there is no food charge for 3 yr. olds

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(the price of 1 qt.)

and under a 20¢ a day charge will be made for these children if milk is used.

- Any opened food left at the lodge on Sun. night will be disregarded by the kitchen hostess, thus if you have food there you wish to take home or ~~go~~ are staying after Sun. let the kitchen hostess know.

- Eating and cooking in motels is permitted, but since most of the dishes and silver were needed for the main dining room, you'll have to supply your own utensils until there is enough to go around.

Beds & linen

- In general beds will be made with fresh linens upon arrival and must be left on Sunday made with clean linens.

For vacation weeks generally no sheets will be provided (unless you've been told otherwise)

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by the reservations chairman, but beds must be left with clean sheets when leaving just the same.

Since the number of sheets is limited and people will be coming & going all week it's just too hard to administer.

- There is generally 1 blanket per permanent bed, but in order to be safe bring any blankets you think you'll need ~~on~~ until the bed situation is adjusted.
- Bunk beds are plywood & require a sleeping bag - air mattress & pillow if you need them.
- no towels will be provided by the club. There are a few towels there but these are meant for emergency use only.
- We will provide all the essential - sheet towels, pillow blanket for guests.
- The linen closet has in it paper cups for the bathrooms, toilet paper & soap.
- The supply closet has all the cleaning supplies. If you have not already contributed some liquid or powdered cleaner and a sponge for bathroom, we'd appreciate

your diving so on your next visit to the lodge. If the ~~g~~ bathroom you are using doesn't have them take them from the linen closet.

- We believe a coke machine will be delivered to the lodge next week and if you feel capable of being chairman of keeping it stocked ~~to~~ please let us know.

- if you are going up there ^{Dec 30} for Xmas and have room in your car let us know, some food for the week-end has to be brought up - 100 or so people eat a lot of food.
